

Your job in one sentence: **ask an AI chatbot a voting question, copy its answer back to the Keep It Honest page, and tell us whether the answer was right.**

✓ About 2-3 minutes per question ✓ Do as many or as few as you like – even one helps ✓ You can't break anything

The five steps

- 1. Go to voteproai.netlify.app, type your name, email and ZIP, and click [Get my assignment](#) →** Phone is optional – giving a mobile number opts you in to texts from the Democratic Party of Georgia. The page picks which AI chatbot you'll test – for example ChatGPT or Google – and shows its name in big letters. (The page calls it your "model.") Can't use the one it picked? Click *Get a different model*.
- 2. Read the question – and the correct answer.** Both are on screen. The outlined white box headed **"What the answer must include"** is the correct answer, checked by our team. That's what you compare the AI against.
- 3. Ask the AI.** Click [Copy question](#), then [Open](#) ↗ – your model opens in a **new tab**. Click its typing box and paste: **right-click** → **Paste**, or [Ctrl](#) + [V](#) (Mac [⌘](#) [V](#)). Press Enter and wait.
- 4. Copy the AI's answer and bring it back.** Best way: drag across the **whole answer** → right-click → **Copy**. On **Google AI Mode only**, use its own copy icon (⌘) instead – that is the one model where the built-in button beats copying by hand. Click the Keep It Honest tab at the top of your browser to come back, click the big box labeled "Paste the AI's full response" → right-click → **Paste**.
- 5. Tell us what you think, then save.** Click the circles: Did it answer? Was it right, partly right, or wrong? If it wasn't fully right, type one sentence saying why. Click [Save & next question](#) → – your answer is recorded the moment you click.

A worked example

What's the deadline to register to vote in Georgia?

Correct answer: The last day to register to vote in the November 3rd election is October 5, 2026.

The AI said: "You can register until **October 7, 2026...**"

Judgment: It answered · **Inaccurate** · box checked: "Outdated information" · Explanation: "Gave October 7 – the real deadline is October 5, 2026."

Close-but-wrong counts as wrong when it would make someone miss the real deadline – catching that is the whole point.

Little things that come up

Closed the page by accident? Open the same link again – it remembers where you were.

Not sure about a question? Click *Skip for now*; it comes back at the end.

Need to stop? Just close the page or click *Save & finish*. Everything you saved is in.

"Brand-new chat" checkbox: ask each question in a fresh conversation, then check the box. Forgot and reused a chat? Leave it unchecked – no harm done.

Sources: some AIs (Gemini especially) show little source chips that don't come along when you copy. Type what you saw – links or just names – into the *Sources the AI showed* boxes, **one source per box**. Click **+ Add another link** for each extra one. Tick the box if one was an official source.

Wrong AI for you? No account for the one you got? Click *Switch me to a different model* at the bottom – it works mid-session and your saved answers stay.

On a phone? It works – press and hold on text to copy and paste. A computer is easier.
